Focus on Fibre Art Studio - Member Access

The Studio has seen regular use mainly by guilds or groups for meetings and drop off/pick up days. We currently have seven guilds booking a monthly or daily time period. See the [Sep/Oct newsletter](#) for info on opportunities for guilds/members, and terms of use.

Individual members may book a 3-4 hour block, with some restrictions, on a trial basis. To date four members have booked a total of 2 days per month. This program will be re-evaluated at year's end.

Members are encouraged to take advantage of the Open Studios if they require more space for a project or if they wish to get together with some friends in a large space. Groups are limited to 12 people to comply with AHS COVID-19 guidelines; there is ample space for each person.
